Google Scholar

Using <u>Library Search</u> allows you to find full-text articles and details of print books and book chapters across all subjects in the UofG Library collections. See our <u>guide to using Library Search</u>.

If you are using Google Scholar make sure to <u>set the University of Glasgow as</u> <u>your linked library</u>. This will add links to full-text next to your search results.

## **Browser extensions**

🔓 unpaywall

Open Access Button finds full-text from aggregated repositories such as unpaywall, CORE, OpenAIRE and Europe PMC. Works with Firefox.

<u>Unpaywall</u> harvests Open Access content from over 50,000 publishers and repositories. Also searches pre-prints. Works with Chrome and Firefox.

Lazy Scholar searches across UofG Library collections and platforms such as





<u>Google Scholar Button</u> offers the same functions of Scholar functions from any other webpage. Works with Chrome, Firefox and Microsoft Edge.
